Red Cross Fire Works Safety

1. Never give fireworks to small children and never throw or point a firework toward people, animals, vehicles, structures or flammable materials.
2. Always follow the instructions on the packaging.
3. Keep a supply of water close by.
4. Make sure the person lighting fireworks wears eye protection.
5. Light only 1 firework at a time and never attempt to relight "a dud."
6. Store fireworks in a cool, dry place away from children and pets.
7. Never use fireworks around pets, keep pets indoors.
